ORAL AND WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS

1. PRESENTATION

1-A. GUEST SPEAKER FROM API FORWARD MOVEMENT

Asian Pacific Islander Forward Movement (APIFM) Project Specialist Kevin Liao presented a "Clean Air SGV" project that has been funded by South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) since 2016. With the grant funding from South Coast AQMD, Purple Air Sensors are installed at residential homes and public facilities to measure the air quality in the San Gabriel Valley area. Between 2017 and 2018, APIFM has installed 50 Purple Air Sensors throughout the San Gabriel Valley. In 2019, they will be installing 64 more Purple Air Sensors within Alhambra and Monterey Park.

Installing the Purple Air Sensors is completely voluntary. Residents can sign up for educational workshops through APIFM by contacting Kevin Liao at Kevin@apifm.org. Workshops are held at APIFM Headquarters in Alhambra.

3-B. MONTEREY PARK NATIONAL NIGHT OUT PARTICIPATION

Chair Wong and Co-Chair Hwong received an invitation from Monterey Park Police Department to participate in the 36th Annual National Night Out scheduled for August 6, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the City Hall front lawn. The Commission planned to participate and host a booth to giving out educational materials about the environment and Public Works Department's program information and event flyers. Additionally, the Commission moved to approve a budget of up to \$150 for the purchase of reusable totes as giveaways.

3-C. FIELD TRIP AT LA COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICTS MRF & WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Chair Wong briefed the Commission that there are two field trips coordinated by the LA County that the Commission can consider attending, including the Joint Water Pollution Control Plant and Bixby Marshland scheduled for August 3, 2019 and the San Jose Creek Water Reclamation Plant, Puente Hills Landfill, and Puente Hills Materials Recovery Facility scheduled for October 5, 2019. The Commission is planning on attending the October 5th field trip.

Co-Chair Hwong announced that Monterey Park Lions Club is having a new president installation on Tuesday, July 16, 2019.

Chair Wong announced that the Mayoral Installation will be on Monday, July 22, 2019 in City Hall Council Chamber from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Youth Advisor Lin announced that PlanetSave partnered with USC and donated four servers to Vanuatu Trade Commission for their school children. Youth Advisor Lin and PlanetSave President Lin are going to film a documentary on the islands of Vanuatu regarding climate change on Third World countries like Vanuatu in August. Their project proposition will be forwarded to the Commission for sponsorships.
