Monterey Park, Calif. - November 10, 2020 - Monterey Park small businesses who have been economically impacted by COVID-19 are invited to apply for the city's [COVID-19 Small Business Assistance Program](#) starting Monday, November 23, 2020.

The online program application will open on Monday, November 23, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. and applications will be accepted and reviewed on a first come, first served basis until program funding has been expended. Applicants must meet specific criteria outlined by federal guidelines.
