Monterey Park Fire Department Responds to Structure Fire at 727 W. Garvey Avenue

Monterey Park, Calif. - November 25, 2019 – On November 23, 2019 at 9:38 a.m. the [Monterey Park Fire Department](#) along with units from Alhambra and Los Angeles County fire departments responded to a reported structure fire at 727 W. Garvey Avenue. An aggressive fire attack was initiated and the fire was contained to the business of origin. No other businesses were damaged as a result of this fire. The fire was knocked down at 9:50 a.m.

No civilians or firefighters were injured during the incident. All businesses in the strip mall were initially evacuated and closed, however, were re-opened once the fire was contained and there was no other danger.

Damage is estimated at approximately \$75,000. The cause of the fire remains under investigation.
