

RESOLUTION NO. 11592

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY PARK, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE Special MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON July 2, 2013 DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Monterey Park, California, on Tuesday, July 2, 2013 as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY PARK, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the precincts except vote by mail and provisional ballots was 2,192; the whole number of vote by mail ballots cast in the City was 3,304; the whole number of vote by mail and provisional ballots (including vote by mail ballots not included in the initial canvassing) cast in the City was 919 making a total of 6,415 votes (ballots) cast in the City.

SECTION 2. That the measure voted upon at the election is as follows:

Measure FF: Shall an ordinance amending the Monterey Park Municipal Code to authorize and direct the City Council to negotiate to transfer all functions of the Monterey Park Fire Department to the consolidated Fire Protection District of Los Angeles County (aka the Los Angeles County Fire Department) be adopted?

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City for and against the measure were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure FF did not vote in favor of it, and that the measure was not carried, and shall not be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) The measures voted upon; (4) For what office each person was voted for; (5) The total number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and for and against each measure; (6) The total number of votes given to each person, and for and against each measure.

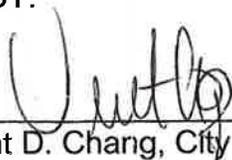
SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

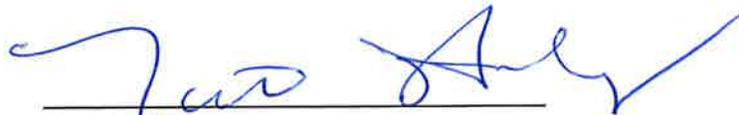

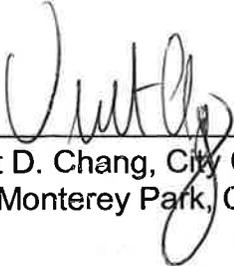

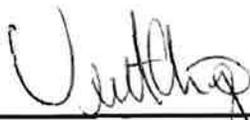
