Asian Pacific American Heritage Month Programs

May 6, 2:00 PM, Friends Room

Filmmaker Ed Moy will screen his short documentary film, "Aviatrix," the story of pioneering aviatrix Katherine Sui Fun Cheung, a Chinese immigrant who defied racial and gender bias to become a daredevil stunt pilot during the Golden Age of aviation in the 1930s. Special guest Dottie Leschenko, daughter of Katherine Sui Fun Cheung, will talk about her mother's adventurous spirit as a stunt pilot following the 40 minute award winning film. Program audience: teens and adults.

Watch the new documentary film on the Chinese Exclusion Act by award winning filmmakers Ric Burns and Li-Shin-Yu. The film highlights the important connections between the Chinese Exclusion Act and the history of American civil liberties, immigration, and culture. Program audience: adults.

1,000 Books Before Kindergarten

The *1,000 Books Before Kindergarten* program encourages parents and caregivers to read 1,000 books with their child before he or she enters school – a goal experts say helps prepare children to be successful readers once they enter school. Reading to children helps develop important literacy skills that provide a solid foundation for learning and academic success.

To participate:

1. **Sign up** at the Children's Desk of the Monterey Park Bruggemeyer Library to receive a 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten reading log and tote bag.
2. **Read together and write the titles** on the reading log. If you read a book more than once, you can record it each time. Books read at library storytime, at daycare, or books that are read by others to your child also count!
3. **After each 100 books**, bring your reading log to the library to:
 - Place your name on our Readers Board.
