Public Hearings will be held to receive community input on district boundaries and maps for the formation of City Council districts for elections commencing with the General Municipal Election in March 2020. The City Council will discuss, consider, and take action on one or more district map(s). The City Council's actions may include modification of district boundaries, sequencing of elections, introduction and adoption of an ordinance, and such other matters as may be related to the formation of City Council districts.
