

RESOLUTION NO. 11557

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY PARK, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 5, 2013 DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Monterey Park, California, on Tuesday, March 5, 2013 as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY PARK, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the precincts except vote by mail and provisional ballots was 2,165; the whole number of vote by mail ballots cast in the City was 2,471; the whole number of vote by mail and provisional ballots (including vote by mail ballots not included in the initial canvassing) cast in the City was 586 making a total of 5,222 votes (ballots) cast in the City.

SECTION 2. That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

That the measures voted upon at the election is as follows:

Measure DD: Shall the ordinance that does not increase the city's telephone utility user tax rate but rather amends the city's telephone utility tax code to reflect changes in electronic communication equipment, methods and regulations be adopted?

Measure EE: Shall the ordinance implementing term limits for the city council, city treasurer, and city clerk be adopted?

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective office for which the persons were candidates and for and against the measures were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that: Hans Liang was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; Peter Chan was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; Vincent Dionicio Chang was elected as City Clerk for the full term of four years; and Joseph Leon was elected as City Treasurer for the full term of four years.

That as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure DD relating to "Shall the ordinance that does not increase the city's telephone utility user tax rate but rather amends the city's telephone utility tax code to reflect changes in electronic communication equipment, methods and regulations be adopted?" did vote in favor of it, and that the measure was carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified;

That as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure EE relating to "Shall the ordinance implementing term limits for the city council, city treasurer, and city clerk be adopted?" did vote in favor of it, and that the measure was carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) The measures voted upon; (4) For what office each person was voted for; (5) The total number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and for and against each measure; (6) The total number of votes given to each person, and for and against each measure.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


