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Monterey Park Bruggemeyer Library Prints PPE for Healthcare Workers



The Monterey Park Bruggemeyer Library is answering a call for volunteers from University of Southern California's Viterbi School of Engineering to 3D print personal protective equipment (PPE) for healthcare staff caring for patients with COVID-19.

Staff members are printing 100-120 ear savers each week, which takes between 40-50 hours of printing. These ear savers provide healthcare workers with much needed relief by protecting ears from chafing caused by medical masks.

COVID-19 Update: Your Frequently Asked Questions

The City of Monterey Park has prepared this list of frequently asked questions and responses to help residents and businesses navigate through the Coronavirus/COVID-19 event. Please be aware that, due to the evolving nature of the issue, information may change at any time. What is Project Roomkey?

Project Roomkey is a collaborative effort by the State of California, LA County and the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority to secure hotel and motel rooms for vulnerable people experiencing homelessness. Project Roomkey seeks temporary housing for people who are experiencing homelessness and have shown no symptoms of the illness. There are two locations in the city, which are Lincoln Plaza Hotel, 123 S. Lincoln Avenue and Garvey Inn, 1040 E. Garvey Avenue. These sites do not accept walk-in or walk-up clients. Prior to arrival, individuals are pre-screened and selected by a homeless services provider then transported to their assigned location. The sites are not being used to quarantine individuals or treat COVID-19 patients, but provide a safe and separate place for vulnerable homeless individuals that are elderly or have underlying health conditions to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Are City Parks and Restrooms Open?

Open space areas at parks are open with physical distancing required but certain recreation amenities, sport courts, and facilities including playgrounds are closed. Physical distancing measures require members of the public to be separated by at least six feet from others. Persons who are members of the same household may be together, but separated from others by a distance of at least six feet. Public and private gatherings and events among persons not in the same household are prohibited. Restrooms at all parks are closed, except for Garvey Ranch Park and Barnes Park restrooms which are open from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Will I Get a Ticket On Street Sweeping Day?

Due to an increase of debris and trash along curbs, street sweeping parking enforcement has resumed.

Are Face Coverings Mandatory?

Per the LA County Health Officer, essential businesses are

required to provide all of their employees whose duties require contact with other employees and/or the public with a cloth face covering to wear. Everyone is required to wear a face covering when they are interacting with others who are not members of their household in public and private spaces. Face coverings are an additional tool that individuals should use to help slow the spread of COVID-19 but they do not replace other physical distancing requirements.

What Food Delivery Services Are Available?

Great Plates Delivered Program: For more information please visit wdacs.lacounty.gov/greatplates/ and to enroll please call 211. Individuals may qualify to receive meals if you:

- Meet age requirements: Are 65 or older OR Are 60-64 and have been diagnosed with or exposed to COVID-19 or are at high risk as defined by the CDC.
- Living alone or with one other program-eligible adult.
- Are not currently receiving assistance from other state or federal nutrition assistance programs, like CalFresh/ SNAP or Meals on Wheels.
- Earn less than \$74,940 (single) or \$101,460 (two-person household).
- Have difficulty accessing food resources or preparing your own meals.
- Live in unincorporated LA County or a city that does not have its own 'Great Plates Delivered' program.

MPK Senior Lunch Program

The City of Monterey Park continues to work with Los Angeles County and the YWCA Intervale San Gabriel Valley to provide meals to Monterey Park residents. Contact Langley Senior Center at 626-307-1395 for details about the program and to register. Seniors 60 years and older must be registered with Los Angeles County Area Agency on Aging to qualify for the lunch program.

Meals-on-Wheels

The Meals-on-Wheels program offers home delivery meals to homebound seniors who are 60+ years old. Frozen meals are delivered to seniors' door, once a week, to enjoy at home. 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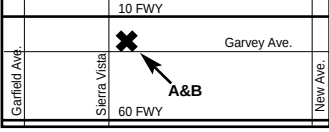
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LAMP Literacy & Claremont Colleges Partner to Provide Online Citizenship Coaching

Liao Yuan is a 39-year-old immigrant who has lived in the United States for five years. He's worked hard for his family and has bloomed where he was planted, but something was missing. He wanted to be a citizen. With recent COVID-19 closures, it wasn't looking good until he connected with the Monterey Park Bruggemeyer Library LAMP Literacy Program and Claremont Colleges volunteers. Now, Monday evenings and his future look brighter.

For over ten years, LAMP Literacy has provided on-site citizenship coaching through a partnership with Kathleen Yep, Professor of Asian American Studies at Pitzer College and Claremont Colleges student volunteers. Closed for on-site classes, LAMP Literacy was making plans to maintain contact, social interaction and learning experiences with its citizenship preparation students. In a stroke of serendipity, Adult Literacy Coordinator Mary Pat Dodson, received a timely e-mail. Volunteers from the Claremont Colleges offered to continue Monday evening citizenship coaching sessions online. Once classes began, the Claremont Colleges students extended the volunteer opportunity to alumni who responded generously.

Through this partnership, more than 20 Claremont Colleges student volunteers have helped nearly 40 would-be citizens online in practicing civics and history, the 100 Citizenship Questions and how to fill out the N-400. This is a break in the clouds of current hardships. It shines an illuminating spotlight on the hearts and actions of this highly appreciated group of volunteers. There's good news - COVID-19 can bring out the best in us. This literacy partnership is only one example of people working together to meet the needs of our community.

One Claremont Colleges-LAMP Literacy Partnership volunteer expressed it this way:
"Working with LAMP was one of the highlights of my college experience and I see the chance to come back as an alum as a silver lining during this unprecedented time. I have been and continue to be so grateful for the opportunity to be a part of this group and connect with the LAMP community in Monterey Park. I leave every session feeling as if I and the other LAMP participants have all learned so much from each other. Specifically, as the child of Asian immigrants myself, it is enlightening to see first-hand the hurdles that come with attaining citizenship. If possible, I hope to continue my participation in LAMP in the future as well."

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Night Sky Report

In June we have a month without planets, and the nights are the shortest in the year.

The summer solstice will occur on June 20. This means the Sun will be as high as it gets in the sky at noon. This is the reason why this date marks the start of summer. It also means the shortest nights of the year since the Sun sets a little past 8 p.m. Pacific time, and rises around 5:40 a.m., and because twilight lasts half an hour or more on either end, that means less than nine hours of night.

June is this year's month without any easily visible planets. In fact, the only one is Mercury, and this will be a challenge. On June 4, Mercury is separated as far east of the Sun as it can get, and therefore it's as visible as it can get. Unfortunately, it sets at 9:50 p.m. while the Sun sets at 8 p.m. This means you'll have about an hour to try and see Mercury before it also sets, given that you need to wait until twilight darkens enough, since it is the faintest of the five planets visible to the unaided eye. If you mark the point where the Sun sets, extend one arm and extend your fingers and thumbs widely, so the tip of your thumb and little finger are as far apart as they can be. Now place the tip of your thumb on the flat horizon, so your little finger is as high in the air as possible. If you don't have a flat horizon, then imagine where it would be. Mercury should be approximately at the tip of your little finger. I've used this technique to see it, but at best, it will just be visible to the eyes as a relatively faint star. Binoculars will help.

Venus is passing between us and the Sun, passing out of the evening skies for the rest of the year. Jupiter and Saturn will not rise in the east until around 1 a.m. on June 1, rising earlier each evening until on June 30 it does so at 10 p.m.

Through a telescope or powerful binoculars, the Moon presents a fascinating and ever-changing panorama of shifting shadows and differences in grays across its surface, especially along the terminator, the line between lunar daylight and night. This is the lunar cycle for June: Full Moon–4th; last quarter–13th; new moon–20th; first quarter–28th.

The bright stars continue their slow march across the sky. Regulus in Leo the Lion shines with a white light to the west. Along the meridian, the line in the sky that goes directly from due north to due south, orange-tinged Arcturus in Bootes shines high overhead, while cold-white Spica in Virgo lies about half way between Arcturus and the horizon as you gaze due south. You might spy copper-tinged Antares in Scorpius in the southeast, while Vega in Lyra shines blazingly white in the northeast.

The Los Angeles Astronomical Society (LAAS) operates the Garvey Ranch Park observatory, located at the end of the park's east parking lot. The observatory has an 8-inch wide 9-foot long refracting telescope to look through, weather permitting, along with a 4-inch scope used to image objects. There's a telescope-making workshop on the ground floor with instruction provided on how to make your own. LAAS volunteers are ready to provide advice and knowledge on all things astronomical, and perhaps on a few other things with a little coaxing. All of this is free of charge. However, when this article was written the facility has been shut down until further notice due to concerns about the spread of the coronavirus. Monterey Park Fire Department: Let's Celebrate the Fourth Legally and Responsibly

The Monterey Park Fire Department wants to wish you and your family a happy and safe Fourth of July holiday. With this patriotic holiday just around the corner, it's a crucial moment to be reminded to celebrate responsibly, especially when it comes to using fireworks. Each year, injuries to children and adults are attributed to the misuse of fireworks. Thousands of dollars in property damage have resulted from the unlawful use and handling of illegal fireworks and firecrackers. So, remember these safety tips, when it comes to buying, using or enjoying your fireworks. If you have any questions, please contact Fire Prevention at 626-307-1308.

Purchase and Use Only "Safe & Sane" Fireworks
Safe and Sane fireworks are the only permitted products allowed in the city and only on July 4 from 10 a.m.-10 p.m. Always purchase fireworks from approved stands and sales outlets. To verify if fireworks are Safe & Sane, look for the official seal of the California State Fire Marshal on the box or individual products. Fireworks are sold from approved, licensed stands from noon on June 28 to 9:00 p.m. on July 4. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, patrons will be required to adhere to all health and safety physical distancing orders provided by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health.

Children Should Not Handle Fireworks
Watching fireworks is especially exciting for young children. While watching from a distance usually poses no safety threat, allowing children to light or handle fireworks is a dangerous practice. A responsible adult should supervise all fireworks activities. Never give fireworks to young children.

Follow Lighting and Safety Instructions Exactly
Each Safe and Sane item will have directions for use. Follow these exactly as stated, and do not attempt to take apart a firework or re-light a "dud." Malfunctioning fireworks, or those you are unsure of, should be disposed of in a nearby bucket of water. Water should be kept on hand for emergencies.

Know Where You Can Legally Use Fireworks
For private use in Monterey Park, residents may use fireworks on their own personal property, in open yard areas, and/or within a driveway. Fireworks should never be lit near any structures or upon any overgrown or dry lawn, and should be kept away from any motor vehicles. It is important to remember that fireworks cannot be used in city parks. Fireworks used contrary to these regulations are subject to immediate confiscation by authorities.

Know the Law and Fines Regarding Fireworks.
Fines have been increased to \$2,000 and \$5,000 per occurrence. Chapter 5.48 of the Monterey Park Municipal Code (MPMC) regulates the sale, use, discharge, and storage of safe and sane fireworks and prohibits the sale, use, discharge and storage of dangerous fireworks. The fines for all violations of Chapter 5.48 relating to fireworks are \$2,000. The unpermitted sale of Safe and Sane fireworks and sale of illegal fireworks is \$5,000. In addition to fine, a citee is liable and responsible for the payment of actual costs associated with the collection, transportation, and disposal of any seized fireworks.

The Greater Monterey Park Chamber of Commerce and the Boys and Girls Club of West San Gabriel Valley are collaborating to give back to healthcare workers through a new campaign called Meals to Heal.

The objective of this campaign is to provide meals to healthcare workers who are working around the clock to contain the COVID-19 outbreak. At the same time, the campaign aims to help local restaurants impacted during the crisis by purchasing meals from them. The program delivered its first meal on April 20, and is currently in its 3rd week of operation. Meals are delivered Mondays through Fridays to a rotating list of health centers.

According to Chamber President Dora Leung, “This is a win-win situation for all. We can support our healthcare heroes and local businesses at the same time.” She also thanks the community and sponsors for their support.

Meals to Heal has worked with several participating restaurants which feature various cuisines, Cuisine variety is a symbol of the great diversity found in San Gabriel Valley.

Recently, Meals to Heal brought at least 500 meals to local hospitals and other healthcare facilities. The current list of hospitals that have benefited from this program are Monterey Park Hospital, Alhambra Hospital Medical Center, Garfield Health Center, Garfield Medical Health Center, Methodist Hospital (Arcadia) and Kaiser Permanente Baldwin Park.

Meals to Heal is aiming to deliver at least 1,000 meals to local hospitals. Meals are paid by donation from members of the community, sponsorships and restaurants themselves. Major sponsors includes Tapatio and Lee Kum Kee.

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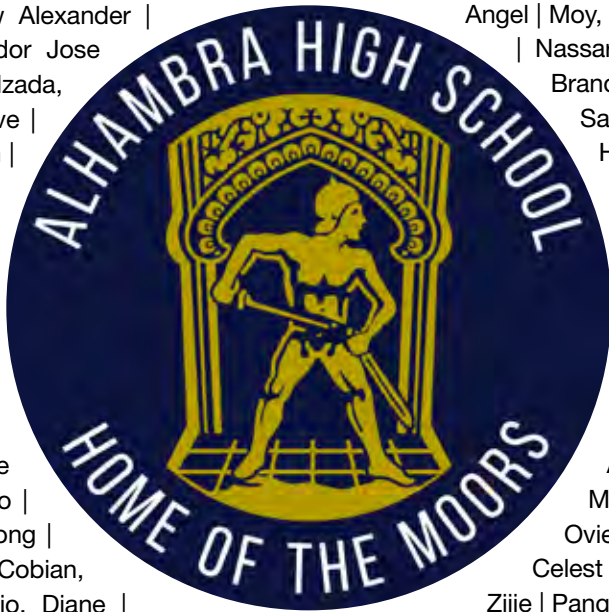

Three AUSD High Schools Earn ‘Best High School’ Honors

For the second year running, U. S. News & World Report’s 2020 BEST PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS named Mark Keppel, San Gabriel, and Alhambra High to their “Best” rankings, after rating nearly 18,000 public high schools in the nation. Within California, Mark Keppel ranked #73, while San Gabriel ranked #156 and Alhambra High ranked #174, out of 3,162 California public schools. California ranks as the first out of 50 states in terms of student enrollment and in terms total number of schools.

The U. S. News & World Report rankings were determined by summing weighted scores across six indicators of school quality: college readiness, college curriculum breadth, math and reading proficiency, math and reading performance, undeserved student performance, and graduation rate.

These high school honors come on the heels of the history-making first of having six AUSD elementary schools win the 2020 California Distinguished School Award, the most ever to win in a single year. Winners include Martha Baldwin, Brightwood, Monterey Highlands, Ramona, Repetto, and Park elementary schools which were singled out for closing the achievement gap and for achieving exceptional student performance.

“We are so proud of our staff, students and parents whose dedication and hard work make such awards possible,” said AUSD Superintendent Denise Jaramillo. “Honors like these are all the more meaningful in this time of school closure amid the global health crisis,”

什麼是門匙計劃Project Roomkey？
門匙計劃項目是加州，洛杉磯縣和洛杉磯無家可歸者服務局的一個項目，旨在為遇到無家可歸的弱勢群體提供安全的酒店和汽車旅館客房。門匙計劃項目為無家可歸且沒有疾病跡象的人們尋求臨時住房。該市有兩個地點，分別是林肯酒店，123 S. Lincoln Avenue 和小台北客棧Garvey Inn，1040 E. Garvey Avenue。這些地點不接受普通或臨時客戶。在到達之前，由無家可歸者服務局對每個人進行預篩查和選擇，然後將其運送到他們指定的地點位置。這些場所不是用來隔離個人或治療新冠病毒COVID-19的患者，而是為老年人或具有基本健康狀況的脆弱無家可歸者提供一個安全而獨立的地方，以幫助防止COVID-19的傳播。

有公園的洗手間都關閉，除了Garvey Ranch公園和Barnes Park洗手間的開放時間為早上6點至晚上10點。

我該如何支付水費單？

市政府清掃街邊的當日我會被開罰單嗎？
目前由於路邊的雜物和垃圾增加，已恢復清掃街道的執法行動。

口罩是必須的嗎？
根據洛杉磯縣衛生官員的要求，基本生活業務的商家必須為所有需要與其他員工和/或公眾接觸的員工提供一塊布面罩以供配戴。當每個人在公共和私人場所與不是家庭成員的其他人互動時，每個人都必須戴上口罩。口罩是每個人應使用的另一種工具，可幫助減緩新冠病毒COVID-19的傳播，但不能代替其人與人之間的身體疏遠要求。

城市公園和洗手間開放嗎？
公園的開放區域還是需要進行人與人之間保持身體疏遠，但某些娛樂設施，運動場以及包括遊樂場在內的設施均已關閉。身體疏遠措施要求公眾，及人與人之間至少保持相距六英尺的距離。屬於同一個家庭的人可能聚集在一起，但與外界人需要保持至少為六英尺的距離。禁止不是同一家庭中的人進行公共和私人聚會和活動。所

 •獨自生活或與其他符合計劃的成年人一起生活。
 •當前未從其他州或聯邦營養援助計劃（例如CalFresh / SNAP或“送餐服務計劃”）獲得援助。
 •收入少於\$ 74,940（單身）或\$ 101,460（兩人家庭）。
 •難以獲得食物資源或無法自己做飯。
 •居住在洛杉磯縣以外或沒有自己的“優質送餐計劃”的城市。

Por favor, tenga en cuenta que debido a la naturaleza de evolución del problema, la información puede cambiar en cualquier momento. La ciudad continuará proporcionando información actualizada y alienta a los constituyentes a visitar www.montereypark.ca.gov/coronavirus o a llamar al escritorio de información de MPK al 626-307-1377 para obtener información y recursos adicionales.

¿Qué es el Proyecto Roomkey?
 El Proyecto Roomkey es un esfuerzo colaborativo del Estado de California, el Condado de Los Angeles y la Autoridad de Servicios para Personas sin Hogar de Los Angeles para obtener habitaciones en hoteles y moteles para personas vulnerables que no tienen donde vivir, El Proyecto Roomkey busca vivienda temporal para las personas que no tienen hogar y que no han mostrado síntomas de la enfermedad. Hay dos ubicaciones en la ciudad, que son el Lincoln Plaza Hotel, 123 S. Lincoln Avenue y Garvey Inn, 1040 E. Garvey Avenue. Estos sitios no aceptan clientes que lleguen sin previa cita. Antes de la llegada, las personas son previamente evaluadas y seleccionadas por un proveedor de servicios para personas sin hogar y luego son transportadas a su ubicación designada. Los sitios no están siendo usados para poner a personas en cuarentena o tratar a pacientes del COVID-19, sino para proporcionar un lugar seguro y separado para las personas sin hogar, vulnerables, que son ancianos o tienen condiciones de salud subyacentes, para ayudar a prevenir la propagación del COVID-19.

¿Están abiertos los parques y baños de la Ciudad?
 Las áreas de espacio abierto en los parques están abiertas con distanciamiento físico requerido pero ciertas amenidades de recreación, canchas deportivas, e instalaciones que incluyen las áreas de juegos infantiles están cerradas. Las medidas del distanciamiento físico requieren que los miembros del público estén separados por lo menos seis pies los unos de los otros. Las personas que son miembros de la misma casa pueden estar juntas pero separadas de otros por una distancia de por lo menos seis pies. Las reuniones y eventos públicos y privados entre personas que no viven en la misma casa están prohibidas. Los baños en todos los parques están cerrados, con excepción de los baños del Garvey Ranch Park y del Barnes Park que están abiertos desde las 6 a.m. hasta las 10 p.m.

 Debido a un aumento de escombros y basura a lo largo de las aceras, se ha reanudado la aplicación de las reglas de estacionamiento durante el barrido de las calles.

¿Son obligatorias las coberturas faciales?
 Según el Oficial de Salubridad del Condado de Los Angeles, los negocios esenciales están obligados a proporcionar a todos sus empleados cuyos trabajos requieran contacto con otros empleados y/o con el público, una cobertura de tela para usar. Todos están requeridos de usar una cobertura facial cuando están interactuando con otros que no son miembros de sus hogares en espacios públicos y privados. Las coberturas faciales son una herramienta adicional que la gente debe usar para ayudar

a aminorar la propagación del COVID-19 pero no reemplazan otros requisitos de distanciamiento físico.

 • Cumple con los requisitos de edad: Tiene 65 años o más O tiene 60-64 años y ha sido diagnosticado o expuesto al COVID-19 o es de alto riesgo según lo definido por el CDC.
 • Vive solo o con otro adulto eligible para el programa.
 • Actualmente no recibe asistencia de otros programas estatales o federales de asistencia nutricional, como CalFresh/SNAP o Meals on Wheels.
 • Gane menos de \$74,940 (solo) o \$101,460 (hogar de dos personas).
 • No tiene fácil acceso a los recursos alimenticios o para preparar sus propias comidas
 • Vive en un área no incorporada del Condado de Los Angeles o en una ciudad que no tiene su propio programa de ‘Great Plates Delivered’.
