RE: Installation of Industrial Waste Grease Interceptor

The Fire Department has provided this guideline to assist development projects constructing restaurant or food service operations that will require an industrial waste grease interceptor.

The following are the most common code references used by the Fire Department:

- California Fire Code (2019 edition) – State minimum with local amendments.
- Monterey Park Municipal Code (Title 17) – Local Requirements.
- Monterey Park Municipal Code (Title 14) – Public Utilities, Sewers and Industrial Waste
- National Fire Codes (NFPA Volumes 1-16) – (State Fire Marshal Referenced Standards).

The following items need to be submitted directly to Monterey Park Fire Prevention:

Step 1

- Plan check submittal requirements for the Industrial Waste plan are submitted directly to the Fire Prevention Department, need to include:
 - Plumbing plans (**6 sets**) with the City of Monterey Park’s Building plan check number stamped on the plans.
 - Completed application for the Industrial Waste Disposal Permit
 - Deposit payable to the City of Monterey Park for \$1,603.35

Step 2

- Plan check services conducted by Los Angeles County, Environmental Program Division.

Take the application, City of Monterey Park receipt, and plans to the County for plan check services.

Step 3

- Return 3 sets of the approved plans to Monterey Park Fire Prevention.

Step 4

You will be invoiced third party costs and issued a fire permit for the Industrial Waste Grease Interceptor. The Fire Department will route one set of approved plans to the Building Division to be included with the architectural drawings, keep one set for your reference.
