Dear Mayor Yang and Council Member Sanchez,

As residents of Monterey Park, we are writing to express our strong support for the 45-day moratorium on data center development and your recent direction to draft a ballot measure for a permanent citywide ban. The proposed facility on Saturn Street represents unacceptable risks to our neighborhood's health, infrastructure, and local economy. A few are highlighted below:

- **Environmental and Health Concerns:** The use of 14 industrial diesel generators poses a direct threat to our air quality and increasing the risk of respiratory illnesses in a densely populated neighborhood. Also with the constant noise from cooling systems and the demand for over 15,000 gallons of water daily, it is not something that will improve our neighborhood.
- **Resource Strain:** This single facility could consume more electricity than all 20,700 households in Monterey Park combined. There has been well documented cases where data centers significantly increased the utility costs for the surrounding neighborhoods.
- **Negligible Economic Benefit:** Despite the massive scale of the facility, it is well known that these data centers create very few permanent jobs once construction is complete. Trading our neighborhood's precious resources, air quality, environment and health for a facility that offers almost no long-term employment or economic benefit is a poor investment for the future.

I urge the Council to remain steadfast in the face of legal threats from the developers. Protecting the long-term well-being of our neighborhood and residents must take priority over industrial expansion that strips our neighborhood of its resources. This data center is a bad deal for Monterey Park.

I look forward to seeing the final ballot language at the March 4 meeting. Thank you for your leadership on this critical issue.
